





Discipline Procedure

by means of a phone call.

- 1) Discussion and counseling with the student regarding the problem by chaperone or Director.
- 2) Notification of the problem to the parent or guardian
- 3) In the event of a very serious problem with complete lack of cooperation on the part of the student, the staff may elect to send the student home via the nearest commercial airline at the family's own expense.
- NOTE: The level of the disciplinary procedure will be determined by the Director and staff.

Passports

- Processing time for new passport or renewals is between 10-12 weeks.

Tour Insurance


- Travel insurance is <u>NOT</u> included in tour cost but highly recommended.


